

Carson Organizes Air Patrol Unit

Carson squadron 961-4 of the civil air patrol was organized last night at the Ormsby county courthouse, with forty members from Gardnerville, Carson and Minden enrolled. The new unit with headquarters in Carson will comprise one flight, one motorized troop, one mounted troop, and a small headquarters section. Kenneth Hamilton, an outstanding Carson flier and a former member of the civil air patrol in California, was named squadron commander.

Training schedules will start next week, and more enlistments are anticipated. Yet to be announced by Hamilton are the men appointed on his staff, and acting company clerks for the three units in the squadron.
