

Mock Air Raids Open Bond Drive

Nevada CAP Planes To Cover State

"Air raids" staged to the scream of warning sirens will open Nevada's E bond drive in the 7th war loan Monday morning.

Civil air patrol planes will "bomb" Nevada communities with thousands of leaflets urging the purchase of E bonds and requesting all Nevada citizens to volunteer their services to local war bond committees.

Arrival of the CAP "bombers" will vary in different communities, depending on distance from the nearest civil air patrol base. The Reno air squadron is expected to shower its load of paper bombs on Reno, Sparks, Carson, Minden and Gardnerville.

The Winnemucca provisional squadron will cover most communities in Humboldt county, while the Battle Mountain squadron will take care of Lander county. The new provisional squadron, being formed in Panaca, Pioche and Caliente, will bomb those communities as the first activity of this new CAP unit. Boulder City will be covered by the Boulder squadron, while Las Vegas, Henderson and Basic Magnesium will be the targets for the Las Vegas squadron.

Instead of forming their own war bond committee as in previous drives, the civil air patrolmen are now serving on general war bond committees. About 400 CAP members will be active in the 7th campaign, officers of the patrol said here today.
